

**Tecate Group Shipping Policy for  
Lithium Ion Capacitors and LIC modules per UN3508,  
61st Edition of the IATA DG Regulations, 2020**

Tecate Group Asymmetric Lithium Ion Capacitors (LICs) and LIC modules less than 0.3Wh are exempt from dangerous goods controls, per the 61st Edition of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations, 2019 (effective January 1, 2020.)

Lithium Ion Capacitors with an energy storage capacity greater than 0.3Wh comply with UN3508 regulations (including Special Provision 372 and 196) and meet all packaging requirements when transported as individual capacitors or modules.

**By meeting these requirements, all Tecate Group LIC capacitors and LIC modules may be transported without DG/HZM restrictions, as detailed by these regulations.**
